

## **Beech Scholarship Fund Application**

**Deadline: April 5, 2019**

The Beech Scholarship Fund will award a \$1,000 scholarship to deserving, minority, students of color. The scholarship will be awarded to qualifying and deserving high school seniors entering Temple University, Cheyney University, Lincoln University, or Community College of Philadelphia as a full-time freshman; or, be a current full-time student at one of the four colleges for the fall 2019 academic year.

The funding commitment from the Beech Scholarship Fund sets a criterion that includes entering with a grade point average of 2.75 or higher and declaring a major in Arts, Business, Engineering, Education, or Liberal Arts, and are active in extra-curricular activities through their school, church, community or work.

### **To be eligible for the Beech Scholarship Fund a student must:**

- Be a U.S. citizen living in Philadelphia County.
- Be a minority student of color.
- Must be a permanent resident of Philadelphia County.
- Out-of-state students are not eligible to apply. Must have graduated from a Philadelphia County high school.
- Graduate Students are not eligible to apply.
- Be a graduating high school senior from a Philadelphia public, private or charter school.
- Be a current full time student at Temple University, Cheyney University, Lincoln University or Community College of Philadelphia.
- Submit an official transcript with the school seal and an authorized official's signature (**High School seniors only**).
- Current college students must furnish a copy of current transcripts or grades and two signed recommendation letters from a professor, administrator, faculty member of the attending University or professional.
- High School students must furnish two signed scholarship recommendation letters from instructors, counselors, or other professionals and submit with application.
- All applicants must submit a valid copy of PA issued identification card, driver's license or passport (ID must show current Philadelphia address to be eligible) and valid school ID with application.
- Submit an essay no less than 1000-words (essays with less than 1000 words are subject to rejection).
- High school seniors must submit a letter of acceptance from admitting University for the fall 2019 semester by May 1, 2019.
- Submit a signed application (**applications must be signed with original signature**). Applications must be completed using blue ink ONLY.
- Not submit two-sided or electronic documents.

### **Essay Criteria**

Essays should be typed and submitted with application. Handwritten essays will not be accepted. Essay should be no less than 1000 words, doubled spaced using Times New Roman 12 font, and based on one (1) of the following questions:

1. Why are you a good candidate to receive this scholarship and what are your future goals?
2. How does your future goals relate to your field of study and why?
